STORYTELLING WITH MAPS: A VIRTUAL WORKSHOP FOR EDUCATORS

WORKSHOP OVERVIEW

The Illinois Geographic Alliance (IGA) is pleased to offer a three-day (9 AM – 3 PM), hands-on workshop that will immerse participants in the art and science of storytelling with maps using ArcGIS Online and ArcGIS StoryMaps. Participants will learn strategies for teaching students how to gather and symbolize data, as well as integrating with text, imagery, and multimedia into effective StoryMaps.

The workshop is aimed at in-service and pre-service high school educators, from any discipline; however, educators at all levels (K-16) are welcome. No prior experience with GIS is needed. The workshop will expand on topics covered in previous GIS workshops offered by IGA.

Join us to learn how to integrate interactive mapping and geographic storytelling into your existing curriculum!

WORKSHOP GOAL

The goal of the workshop is to provide participants with concepts for integrating storytelling with maps into their existing curriculum. Attendees will learn key principles using ESRI's ArcGIS StoryMaps.

The workshop will also cover steps for acquiring free ESRI GIS software for use in the classroom.
